First semester BSc Nursing

Student satisfaction survey was conducted for the year 2023-24 among First semester BSc nursing students, which revealed that 27.9% of the students commented that they have excellent orientation given about the course at the beginning of academic year and 27.9% of them commented that they got excellent explanation of course objectives by faculty members. 18% of them commended that evaluation were conducted in an excellent manner according to pre planned schedule. 19.7 % of students commented that clinical experience provided by the institution were excellent and 13.1 % commended that implementation of internal assessment was good as per university norms. 30% were commended regarding the mentor - mentee program as excellent and 23.3% were commented that support provided by their mentor in academic activities were excellent.

Third semester BSc Nursing

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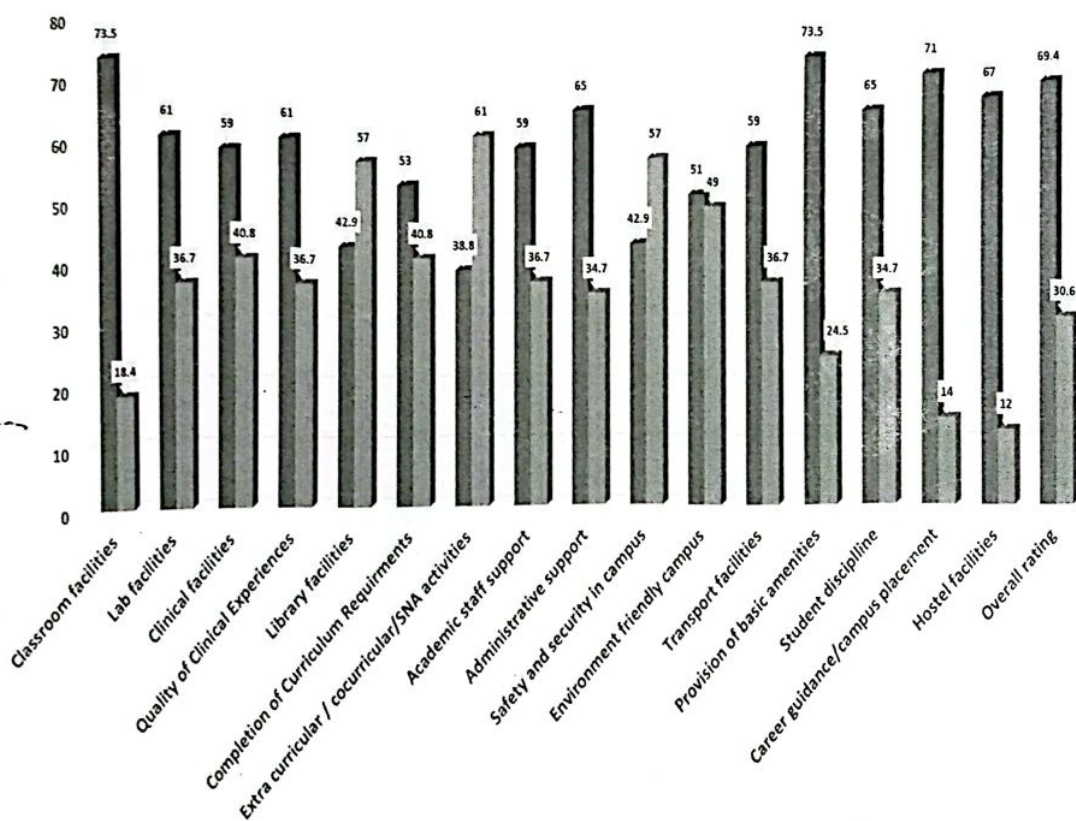


GRADUATES SATISFACTION SURVEY ANALYSIS REPORT

2023-2023

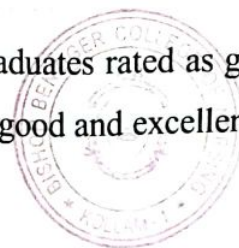
Among IV Year B.Sc. Nursing students, a survey on graduation satisfaction was done in 2023–2024. The results showed that 18.4% of the graduates assessed the college's classroom facilities as excellent, while 36.7% rated its lab facilities as excellent. The clinical facilities were rated as excellent by 40.8%. The college library was regarded as excellent by 57.1% of the graduates.

On quality of clinical experiences, 61.2% of the graduates rated as good, 36.7% as excellent. 53.1% & 40.8% of them evaluated as good and excellent on





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the completion of curriculum requirements. Academic staff support was rated as good 59.2% & excellent 36.7% by an outgoing students.

34.7%, 57.1%, & 49% of the students evaluated as an excellent on administrative support, safety and security and environment friendly in the campus respectively.

Graduates 36.7%, 24.5%, & 34.7% rated as excellent on transport facilities, provision of basic amenities (drinking water, toilets, canteen) and student discipline respectively.
