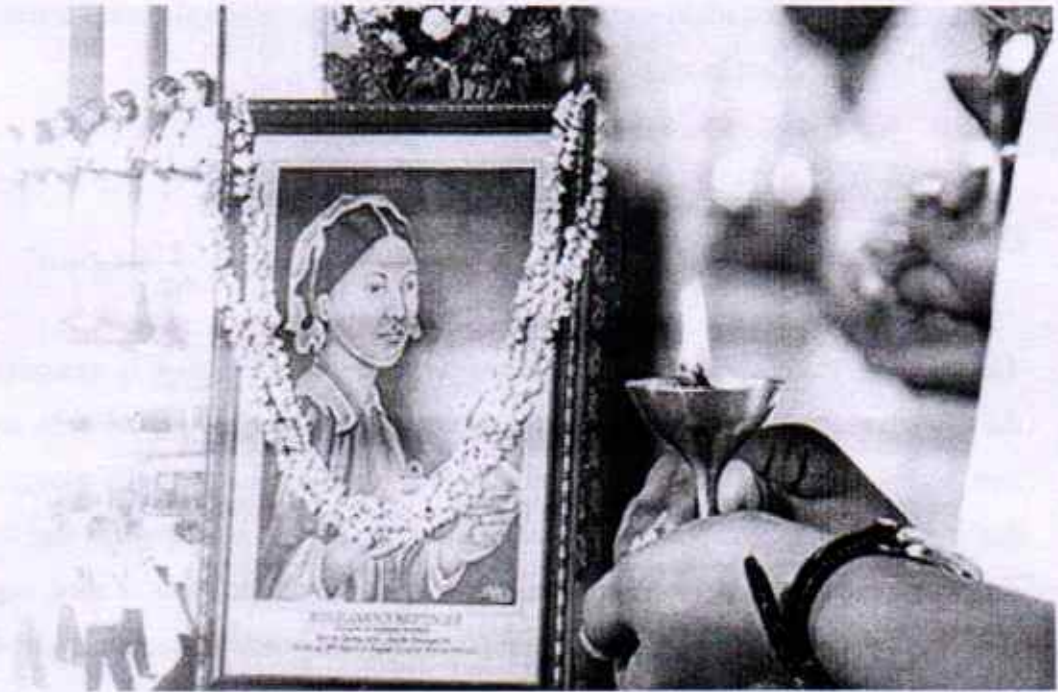

## **BISHOP BENZIGER COLLEGE OF NURSING**

Bishop Benziger college of nursing came into existence in the year 2004 and the institution seeks to make qualitative contribution to health care through training personnel who are dedicated to the healing ministry. The college is managed by the Diocese of Quilon for development of Latin Catholics. The Motto of the institution is "TO LOVE IS TO SERVE". The college is situated in the heart of Quilon city and offers training in B.Sc and M.Sc nursing courses. The college is approved and recognized by KNC, INC and Kerala University of Health Sciences. Bishop Benziger hospital, our parent hospital established in the year 1948, is a 600 bedded multi and super speciality hospital which also runs a school of nursing since 1971 with an intake of 50 students.

## COLLEGE RULES AND REGULATIONS

All students of BISHOP BENZIGER COLLEGE OF NURSING are expected to follow the rules and regulations of the institution.

### PUNCTUALITY AND DISCIPLINE

- All students should be present in college/hospital at least five minutes before the commencement of class /duty (starting at 8am to 5pm)
- Students are responsible to the Principal of the college. Students have to observe punctuality and discipline in class and clinical area.
- Parents/ Guardians are not allowed to visit the classroom/clinics during working hours.
- Students are strictly prohibited from organizing together or collective bargaining. Any redressal should be to the right person, individually.
- Students are strictly prohibited from participating in political agitation and organizing meetings in the Institution premises.
- Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the class, campus and library during working hours by the university. Cinematic dance and fashion show have been prohibited in campus by the government.
- No collection whatsoever will be made by students/staff without the prior permission of the principal.
- All Catholic students should compulsorily attend the mass on first Friday of each month.

### MEDIUM OF COMMUNICATION

- Medium of Instruction for all subjects shall be English. Students have to communicate among themselves and to the teachers and office in English.





## DRESS CODE

- While in the campus the students are expected to be well groomed and in formal dress. Saree, Salwar / Churidar and Kameez are the permitted dress for girls (No jeans, short tops or midy tops are permitted).
- Male students should wear formal shirt (tucked in) and trousers and not informal wears like T-shirts, Jeans, etc. Students are expected to dress modestly.
- In clinical settings all students must be in neat and complete uniform to maintain their professional identity.
- All students have to wear their college identity cards during class hours and clinical posting

## LEAVE AND HOLIDAYS

- Students should strictly follow the leave policy which is laid down by the college authorities. Public holidays for the year will be displayed on notice board as per the University calendar.
- Six weeks' vacation per annum as mentioned in the syllabus will be given to the students i.e., one-week holiday each during Holy week, Onam, Christmas and other university approved public holidays. Students shall carry out the health care services as and when called for during medical emergency situations. Bandhs and Hartal days may be declared holidays, if violence is anticipated on the roads. Students are expected to complete their requirements and compensate the required hours before examination.
- Any special permission/ special leave should be obtained from the principal through proper channel before / prior to availing/ taking it.
- In case of any emergencies at home, sanction has to be obtained from the Principal through the class advisors/class teachers/class coordinator.
- Students who are absent for more than two weeks, without permission will be removed from the rolls. A candidate who is absent for a total of more than 60 days continuous or interrupted within a period of three months during an academic year shall not be eligible to continue the course with the same batch of students. He/ she may obtain special sanction for readmission with the junior batch from higher authorities (University / DME/ Govt. of Kerala).



### DISCONTINUING COURSE

Rules for discontinuing the course after admission will be according to the university norms. Details can be obtained from LBS prospectus and web site of Kerala University of Health Sciences.

### HEALTH AND SAFETY

- The students who suffer from infections or contagious diseases are not allowed to attend classes and parents should report the case immediately.
- Students have to undergo blood, urine, stool and X-ray chest investigations at Bishop Benziger Hospital at the time of admission and any further detailed evaluation if necessary. An annual health checkup is done and recorded in the health chart. The teacher-in-charge of the student's health service will maintain the health record for each student. The student has to report to this teacher regarding any ailments or allergy, so as to make appropriate charting in the health record. Unless the student is very sick, parents will not be informed. Medical facilities availed (Investigations and drugs) has to be paid by the student and the amount may be refunded as permitted under the insurance cover.
- When a student falls sick in the hostel, he/she has to report to the warden, when in the class room to the teacher, in the clinical area to the clinical supervisor. He/she has to see the Doctor and get the sick leave certified, if any advised. Parents of students who are absent or sick should report to authorities

### EXAMINATION:

University examination shall be conducted at the end of each year.

- a. Candidates shall be eligible to appear for university examination only if they have 80% of attendance in theory and 100% in practical with satisfactory progress report.
- b. If the candidate fails in any year he/she is permitted to continue the next year and appear for the subsequent university examination.





- c. If a candidate fails in all subjects in a year he/she will not be permitted to continue the next year. In case the candidate fails in one subject he/she will be allowed to continue the next year, and permitted to take up the examination in the failed subjects and also the regular examinations. In case if he/she fails in the previous year subjects the results of the regular year will be with held until he/she clears all the earlier year subjects and will be allowed to continue the subsequent year.
- d. B.Sc nursing candidates are eligible to appear for the final year examination only if she/he passes, I and II and III year-examination and completes all the academic requirements.
- e. M.Sc nursing candidates shall not be allowed to appear for the second year examination till such time that he/she passes all subjects of the first year M.Sc nursing examination.
- f. All candidates must submit their dissertation works priorly as instructed by respective guides.

**INTERNAL ASSESSMENT**

Weekly test papers and three Sessional examinations will be conducted and the average of these will be calculated for internal assessment. Progress cards will be sent home after Sessional examinations which should be signed by the parent and returned. It is compulsory that the students should secure fifty percent of marks (separately for theory and practical) in the internal evaluation to be eligible to appear for the university examination.

Marks of evaluation by other methods like assignments, seminars, projects etc.can be added to the internal marks.

**GRADING AS PER KUHS**

- Distinction - 75 % and above.
- First Class - 65% and above
- Second class - 50 %

Candidates who pass all parts of examination on the first occasion of appearing there of shall be ranked in order of proficiency as determined by the total marks obtained. Candidates who pass the examination in subsequent appearance shall be ranked only in second class.



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**Award of Rank:-** Rank in the examination- Aggregate marks of all the 4 years regular examination shall be considered for awarding rank. A consolidated mark list consisting of all 4 year examination shall be given to all the students. However a candidate who fails in one or more subject during the course shall be not eligible for the award of rank and medals.

### **RECORD SUBMISSION**

Students must complete their requirements and submit the practical records to the Principal duly signed by the respective teachers two weeks prior to the commencement of examination to be eligible to appear for the university examination.

### **HOSTEL**

Hostel accommodation is available in the institution premises with adequate supervision in academic and spiritual activities. All the students should adhere to the rules and any violation will be viewed seriously. Visitors are allowed on visiting time only. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Recreation facilities are available like in door games and television.

### **LIBRARY**

The college library is a place for silent study and reading. Members should strictly follow these rules and regulations. The college library has an open access system. Use books freely, but do not put them on the shelves. Members may please take the help of the librarian whenever they find any difficulty in locating the books.

**STUDENT SUPPORTIVE SERVICES**

***Guidance and counseling***

### *Educational programs*

We organize and participate in Various National and International programs including workshops, seminars etc to upgrade our student's knowledge and skills.

### *Tutorial Services and Campus interviews*

Special tutorial services are provided to prepare our students for university examinations.

Campus interviews of many reputed institutions in India are facilitated by our college, foreseeing the better future of our students.

**Scholarships:** Various scholarships are provided to the eligible students as described below:

- **MOMA scholarship:** this scholarship will be available to all students belonging to minority community having annual family income less than Rs.2.5 lakhs. The scholarship is sanctioned by department of minority affairs, Govt. of India. Students admitted under government as well as management quota are eligible to apply for this scholarship. The scholarship amount will be in between Rs.25000-30000/, based on the distance from student's residence to college.
- **Government scholarship paid by management:** The students admitted to B.Sc nursing under government quota are eligible for this scholarship. 10 students having lower income and SEBC having annual income below Rs.4.5 lakhs will be selected for scholarship. The scholarship amount will be Rs. 25000/ annually.
- **SC, ST and OEC students** admitted under government quota are eligible for full fee concession along with actual boarding and lodging charges.
- **Children of fishermen** admitted under government quota whose parents are members of Fishermen Welfare Fund Board are eligible for scholarship amount of Rs. 57000/ annually.
- **M.Sc. nursing students** belonging to minority community are eligible to apply for MOMA scholarship provided their family income does not exceed Rs. 2.5 lakhs annually.
