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2.5.4 - Policy for Midcourse





Guidelines for the Midcourse Improvement of the students

- 1. Slow learners are identified based on their:
 - performance in academic performance assessed through continuous evaluation process like unit test, sessional examinations and clinical evaluation.
 - performance in University Examination of previous year and internal examinations (The students who got below 50% of marks).
 - > attendance percentage (less than 60%).
 - self-reporting by the student.
- The institution provides opportunities for the improvement of students in academic performances such as tutorials, discussions quiz ,Question paper solving and make up assignments .
- 3. The department faculties take special effort to teach those students and assess them frequently.
- Faculties also discuss the poor performance of such students with their mentee to find out the reason of low performance and apply remedial measures if required.
- Special coaching classes are given for the identified students prior to the university exam by the concerned subject experts.
- 6. Previous question paper is analyzed, and answer key provided for the students as a study aid.

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- OSCE Sessions are conducted in the concerned laboratory for the improving the practical skills of the weak students.
- 8. Effectiveness of the tutorials are identified and recorded based on the performance of the students.
- 9. The students performance on the tests and assignments will be communicated to the students with in a week.
- 10. The parents will be informed about their students performance on the day of Parent Teacher Association meetings and through progress cards.
- 11. The students who fail in the sessional examination will be given an opportunity to improve their academic performance and also allowed to appear for the retest.
- 12. The retest will be conducted within one week of distribution of answer sheets of sessional examinations.
- 13.The mentor mentee meeting will be conducted on need basis where the students will be guided by the mentor if they need any support for their study.
