POLICY :

Undertaking Research

Faculty members of Bishop Benziger College Of Nursing and departmental research are expected to undertake at least one research per year leading to quality publications, presentations in National/International conferences ,socially useful outcome and other similar research activity.

Obligations of faculty and researchers (including post graduate researchers)

Research output will be considered one of the criteria for faculty recruitment and promotion along with other academic responsibilities.

Recruitment and Promotion

A special weightage is there for the Recruitment and promotion of faculty members and researchers who have demonstrable/demonstrated capability in research. Faculty promotion may significantly depend on research undertaken. The quality of research output, especially research publications, may be assessed on the established yardsticks such as Impact Factor (IF), U.G.C approval and scopes index which will be revised from time-to-time as appropriate.



Research Management

Overall management of research activities may be coordinated by P.G co-ordinator-cum-Vice-Principal. Research advisory body and Institutional Ethics Committee shall be responsible for overall functioning of research activities within the College Of Nursing.
