



#### **Health Survey**

The 46 NSS volunteers divided themselves into five subgroup and each subgroup had 10 volunteers. The volunteers from each subgroup under the supervision of one faculty from BBCON and a mother PTA member from St.John's U.P School. The survey format were distributed to volunteers by NSS Program Officer. Each students got 05 health survey format.

The main objective of conducting health survey was to:

- > To gather basic quantitative information like demographic and socioeconomic variables
- > To identify the environmental hygiene and the health status of people in community
- > To collect the common health behaviors



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- > To find out the non-communicable diseases
- > To identify the blood group with a view to develop a blood group directory
- ➤ To gather information about the role of government and private facilities in providing health care.

After assigning the community area for health survey the volunteers moved to "Thirumullavaram" area to conduct health survey. Each volunteers visited total 05 houses in their area and completed the health survey format with great enthusiasm. The survey finished at 12.30 pm and returned to St.John's U.P School at 1pm.





02pm -3.30pm

The afternoon session of the camp had Miss.Ancy.B.Kairali from Department of Mental Health ,District Hospital Kollam to take a class on "Mental Health and Mental Health Problems in Women". She emphasized on early recognition of mental illness and importance role of volunteers in





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the society in reducing the stigma related to mental illness. In the end of the session ,Ms. Ancy .B.Kairali demonstrated some mind relaxing exercise to volunteers.

Another is that inculcating the spirt of care can have a positive effect on the attitude of volunteers. With the support from local government palliative team from Sakthikulangara, Mrs.Julliet (Palliative Nurse, PHC, Sakthikulangara) provided an opportunity to meet and visit the homes of palliative patients under the supervision of ASHA workers in each area. The volunteers went with ASHA workers and conducted home visit in total 10 houses and done procedures and interacted with the patients and also their families. Volunteers experienced the life of bed ridden patients.

#### **Blood Grouping and Blood Donation Camp**

The NSS volunteers organized and conducted a free blood grouping and blood donation camp along with the support of Bishop Benziger Hospital on 23.02.2020 from 09.30 am to 01 pm at St.John's U.P School, Thirumullavaram. At 09 am registration for camp started. The NSS volunteers divided into different groups and the people were lead to different areas of health camp.
