



Review comments of the study

Title: "Community needs assessment and challenges during COVID-19 outbreak: A step towards developing need based intervention and best practice in India".

Methodology : Since approach chosen is mixed methods and design as exploratory sequential design where Qualitative study is followed by quantitative study its better to rearrange the objectives . second and third objectives should be stated in the beginning.

Data collection methods can be in-depth interviews and FGDs conducted in virtual platforms. Permission for recording should be sought each participant . Separate interview and FGD guides has to be prepared in consultation with experts for each stakeholder category.

Sampling process is not clearly mentioned . how these states are chosen . For quantitative phase better to do a multistage cluster sampling .As the study involves various sample category, ie: varied age groups ,it is suggested to have a sampling plan and sampling criteria clearly specified for deciding the stakeholders.

As the tool has to be used in different setting and languages it has to be revalidated after translation to check for essential psychometric properties .Permission need to be obtained through mail if any standard questionnaire is used . As various raters are involved, inter rater / interobserver reliability and internal consistency reliability need to estimated.

Estimation of samples. How it was done ..? Sample size is fixed as 1200 , but how did you fix this number is not explained.

Assurance of maintaining confidentiality of the data collected and data safety need to be explained clearly to the participants through a participant information sheet .

Data analysis part need to be detailed .

Study can be approved with modification as suggested.
