# **Scholarship Policy**

The goal is to award scholarship to applicants to a transparent system based on the guidelines Students applying for Government scholarship for the first time (**Fresh Students**) need to "**Register**" on the portal as fresh applicant by providing accurate and authenticated information as printed on their documents in the "**Student Registration Form**".

Students who are applying for management scholarship shall apply directly, through the administrative office.

### Guidelines of scholarship

- 1. All scholarship applications received shall be scrutinized based on merit criterion.
- 2. The eligibility guidelines shall be indicated in the application form
- An equitable distribution of scholarship is ensured by the principal based on merit/s and promotion of a program, not compromising on the competitive merit and qualifications of the eligible candidate.
- The scholarship is awarded depending on the availability of endowment funds and annual budget allocation toward scholarship, hence, award amount of scholarship may vary.
- 5. The student has to satisfy the entire criterion indicated in the form. While awarding the scholarship the college considers the merit status of previous year.
- 6. All eligible students are required to submit the scholarship application form on or before last date.
- It is the responsibility of the student to submit all documents along with application for consideration.
- 8. The scholarship award clearly mentions the amount, type of scholarship
- (partial/full/tuition fee waiver for specific period/special categories), duration and terms of reference for renewal of scholarship.
- No student shall be allowed to avail more than one scholarship at any point of academic period.
- 10. Scholarship shall be disbursed based on their academic performance of student, attendance.
- 11. An awardee student maintains good grades with no backlog in each academic year. The decision on renewal of scholarship shall be communicated to student on time.

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#### **Scholarships and Awards**

Our students are eligible for all scholarships granted by government of India & Kerala. They are also eligible for institutional and scholarships given by other organizations/NGOS/Associations.

The following scholarships are awarded to students of our institution:

- Merit cum means scholarship is awarded to the students belonging to minority communities. The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the poor and meritorious students belonging to minority communities to enable them to pursue their course.
- LBS Scholarship (Government. of Kerala)
- E-Grantz :- to SC/ST students. For details visit www.e-grantz.kerala.gov.in
- Scholarships are sponsored by various organizations like SNA, TNAI, and Non-Governmental organization like Vincent d Paul, Kerala motor transport workers welfare fund board, Kerala Builders and construction workers development co-operation.
- Fisheries scholarship: Educational assistance to all the post matric Fisherman's children. It provides provision for making online application, processing and sanction of educational assistance.

KUHS Scholarship: - The Section-6(xxii) of the Kerala University of Health Sciences Act, 2010 empowers the University to institute award, fellowships, travelling fellowships, scholarships, studentship, medals, and prize for teachers and students of University and affiliated colleges. In the University accordingly decided to institute "KUHS-STUDENTSHIP" scheme for the benefit of financially backward students of the affiliated institutions of Kerala University of Health Sciences by way of financial support to them.

## SALIENT FEATURES OF THE SCHEME

1. The scheme is named as "KUHS-STUDENTSHIP".

2. The assistance under the scheme is available only to the students whose family annual income not exceeding Rs.50, 000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only).

3. The scheme intends to give one time assistance to the eligible students who got admission in Government merit quota.

4. The objective of the scheme is to give assistance to financially backward students which would encourage such students in their studies.

5. The assistance will be limited to second year undergraduate students of all streams of medical and allied sciences who got admission during the year 2017.

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#### **Documents needed:**

- 1. Educational documents of student
- 2. Student's Bank account number and IFSC code of the bank branch.
- 3. Aadhaar number of the Student
- 4. If Aadhaar is not available, then Bonafide student certificate from college and
- 5. Aadhaar Enrolment ID or Scanned copy of Bank passbook

6. If Institute is different from domicile state of the applicant, then Bonafide student certificate from college.

7. A completed application form, Letters of recommendation, personal information and official fees structure.
