INSCOL CENTRE FOR CONTINUING NURSING EDUCATION

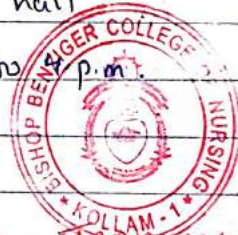
As a part of campus recruitment a class was organized by INSCOL centre for continuing nursing education with a learning outcome of
