ANNUAL REPORT OF CAREER GUIDANCE DURING THE PERIOD OF 2015-2020

Career guidance classes are arranged regularly in every year for the newly admitted batch of students during their orientation programme.

2015-2016

In August 12th 2015, a career guidance programme was arranged for the 3rd and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing students to improve their personality and make them skilled in attending interviews. The class was taken by Mr. George Antony, HOD of Management Studies, Jerome institute of management, Kollam.

2016-2017

A career guidance programme was organized by ABC study links about various opportunities to study and work in Canada. They provided knowledge regarding various study programmes in nursing, including its fee structure and benefits. The 3rd and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing students and teaching faculties were the beneficiaries of the programme.

2017-2018

A seminar on immigration services was conducted in the college by KAN (Agency of Canada) on 26th august 2017. The discussions included the procedure, educational qualifications and economy involved in migration to Canada. The 3rd and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing students and the 1st and 2nd M.Sc. Nursing students participated in the seminar.

2018-2019

As a part of career guidance a class was organized by INSCOL centre for continuing nursing education with a learning outcome to:

- Apply the concept of reflective practice.
- Identify the factors that facilitate and inhibit reflective learning.
- Design one's own learning through various strategies of reflection.



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• Relate significance of reflective practice in contemporary healthcare industry.

Our 3rd and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing students Nursing and teaching faculties attended the class. It was a certified course conducted on 05/06/2018.

On 28th June 2018, BLS training programme was organized by our college to the 3rd and 4th year B.Sc students and M.sc nursing students. It was conducted by Dr. Gopakumar and team. The training programme had both theoretical and practical sessions. There was a pre- test and a post- test practical demonstration. All our students passed and secured a good percentage.

2019-2020

As an intiative to create an awareness about passport related information and services to citizens in a timely, transparent, more accessible, reliable manner and in a comfortable environment through streamlined process, a passport awareness class was conducted for 3rd and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing students on 28/06/2019 at Bishop Benziger College of Nursing Kollam from 3.00 pm to 4.00 pm. The class was led by Mrs. Latha, office staff of Passport authority, Kollam. She gave detailed information regarding how a student can apply for passport, what are the relevant documents required for applying the passport, about the reissuing of passport, the importance of police clearance certificate and general orientation regarding the passport office. All B.Sc. Nursing students were informed regarding this opportunity and advised them to discuss this matter with their parents and inform the college authority about their willingness. Students of 3rd and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing B.Sc. along with their Assistant Class Coordinator attended the class.

In collaboration with the Ministry of External Affairs, the Bishop Benziger College of Nursing got a golden opportunity to apply for passport to all our batch students from 15/07/2019 to 18/07/2019. Two staffs from Passport Office Kollam came to our college and helped the students for processing their application process. All the required certificates were submitted by the students for the data process. The students who had completed their passport processing are:

IVth Year B.Sc. Nursing: 32 Students

IIIrd Year B.Sc. Nursing: 23 Students



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IInd Year B.Sc. Nursing: 40 Students

Ist Year B.Sc. Nursing : 32 Students

The staffs from TCS informed students that only after police verifications; final passport will be issued. Name of the staffs who came from Passport Office were Mrs. Latha and Mr. Sarith.

As a part of career guidance programme an orientation class regarding communicative English and OET was given to the present 4th year B.Sc. Nursing students. They conducted various classes and English tests to check the students English language proficiency and versatility. The members who came for training programme were Mr. Oommen Varghese, OET trainer and Mrs. Jasmine Mohammad, CMD Aman group. The students of 3rd year and 4th year B.Sc. Nursing attended the class.

As a part of the career guidance programme an OET training course prolonging 60 hrs was started for the 3rd and 4th year B.Sc. nursing students from 29th February 2020 on all Saturdays from 3 to 6pm. In relation to this programme a MOU was signed between the college and British institute. It was headed by Mr. Jasmine Mohammad CMD Aman group. Signing and exchange of MOU was done by Rev. Fr.
