



Documents for admission to N.R.I. Category Seats:

An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father/ Mother / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) / Husband / Wife / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother / Half Brother / Half Sister / Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad” will only be eligible to apply in the N.R.I category seats. (As per the GO (MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014). **Copy of the following documents duly attested by the Embassy to prove the NRI status shall be submitted at the time of admission** (As per Order No. ASC 100/20/NRI admission Nursing dt.22/01/2020 and Order No. 2891/ACI/GENA2/KUHS/2017 dt.12/05/2017.)

- A candidate, who apply for the NRI seat should submit the **Passport copy and Visa/Green Card/OCI Documents** of their respective sponsors. The Job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents.
- The **Visa of the sponsor** should be **valid till the closing date of admission** in respect of the Nursing Course.
- In case, the **Employment of the sponsor is not mentioned** in the above documents, the candidate has to produce the **employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Embassy/ Consulate authorities**.
- **Relationship Certificate** to be issued by the Revenue Authorities to prove the relationship between the candidate & the sponsor as per GO(MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014. However, the relationship between the candidate and his/her father/ mother, which are recorded in the educational certificates, maintained in the usual course of transactions by the competent authorities, shall be accepted. Relationship should clearly be established. In case relationship is mentioned as Niece/ Nephew/ Cousin/ Uncle/ Aunt etc., the Village Officer should give an explanation of the relation in the certificate itself. The relationship link should be clearly explained. Certificates showing mere Niece/ Cousin/ Uncle/ Aunt without establishing clear relationship link will be rejected. Candidates shall verify the certificate properly before submitting online.

- The Candidate shall produce a **Sworn affidavit from the Sponsor**, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and the all expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the Sponsor. **During the preparation of affidavit, if the sponsor is in Kerala, then it should be in a stamp paper worth Rs. 200/- and notarized by the Notary Public and attach the passport entry exit page of sponsor. In case, the sponsor is abroad, the sponsor has to submit the affidavit should be attested by the Embassy / Consulate authorities.** (find specimen format Annexure-1).

N.B.: All the certificates/documents required to establish NRI Status shall be produced at the time of submission of application itself. The certificate produced later shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
